The Bremer County Board of Supervisors met in session on Wednesday, October 25, 2017 in the Courthouse, Waverly, Iowa, at 8:30 a.m. Neil, Kammeyer and Hildebrandt present. Finance Director, Kassandra Johansen present. Unless otherwise noted, all actions were approved unanimously.

Meeting was called to order by Chairman Kammeyer, Hildebrandt moved/Neil second to approve the agenda.

Board drove the following county roads to view completed road projects and potential upcoming projects: Midway Ave. bridge; County Road V5C new blacktop; V62 south of Highway 3 possible re-surfacing shared with Fayette County ; V56 railroad bridge removal; Quarter Ave. intersection with Highway 3; and 250<sup>th</sup> west off Highway 63.

Board met with Clint Deutsch to further discuss request for county participation in a HMGP buyout grant for property at 1065 Easton Ave., Nashua, Iowa.

Travis Toliver, Executive Director, and Paula Stevenson, Individual Investor, Waverly Chamber of Commerce, met with Board to give an update.
